



Who's at risk of IgA nephropathy and FSGS?

IgA nephropathy



IgA nephropathy is most commonly found in people with **East Asian ancestry**. Those of Asian descent tend to be from **China, Japan, Korea, or Singapore**.¹ It can also be found in people with **European descent** and in **Hispanics**.^{2,3}



In the United States, IgA nephropathy is **twice as likely** to occur in men⁴

FSGS



Focal segmental glomerulosclerosis (FSGS) is more common in people of **West African ancestry**, particularly those from **Ghana and Nigeria**.⁵ It carries a risk that's 3.5 times higher among **Black Americans** and 2 times higher among **Hispanics** than White Americans^{6,7}



FSGS is nearly **twice as likely** to occur in men⁸

proteinuria / pro-teen-yur-EE-uh / • Proteinuria occurs when protein leaks into urine and can be a sign of kidney conditions if it's persistently high.⁹ Tracking your proteinuria levels with your doctor is important to understanding the health of your kidneys.¹⁰
